Dear Parents/Carers

The Etone College Sports Day will be taking place this year at the Pingles Sports Stadium in Nuneaton on Monday 2nd July. All pupils will be involved during this day, either participating or supporting their house.

Due to the amount of pupils at Etone, the day has had to be split into two sessions. This is to accommodate travelling to the venue and the participation by our pupils. The plan for the day is as follows:

Years 9 and 10

Pupils will be expected to attend College at the usual time but in their PE kit and will be escorted to the Pingles with their form tutor for Sports Day to commence at 9.40am.

Pupils will be dismissed from the Pingles at 12.30pm and appropriate arrangements should be made for your child to go home from the Pingles. Your child is your responsibility from this point. If your child travels by taxi, please inform the taxi company. If your child receives free school meals, they will be provided with a packed lunch before leaving the Pingles.

Years 7 and 8

Pupils will be expected to attend College at the usual time but in their PE kit. Pupils will attend normal lessons in the morning, followed by a lunch break, prior to making their way to the Pingles for a 12.40pm Sports Day start.

Pupils will be dismissed from the Pingles at 3.00pm and appropriate arrangements should be made for your child to go home from the Pingles. If your child travels by taxi, please inform the taxi company.

For the last couple of years Etone's Sports Day has experienced varied weather conditions. We therefore advise that your child is well equipped for the day with a cap, sun cream and plenty of water. This is in addition to any other equipment they will need for the day. If the weather is too severe, then sports day may be cancelled and we would return to the normal College day.

As a safeguarding measure, unfortunately we are unable to invite parents/carers to attend this year.
