End of Term – December 2021

I am writing to inform you about the arrangements for the end and start of term. School will close for pupils on Friday 17th December at 12.30pm

If your child is entitled to free school meals and wishes to collect a packed lunch on Friday 17th December, please email <u>postbox@etonecollege.co.uk</u> by no later than 12 noon on Tuesday 14th December.

On Friday 17th December, pupils will be allowed to wear a Christmas jumper over their shirt and tie for a donation to the Save the Children Charity. Pupils who choose to wear a Christmas jumper should bring a £1 donation to school on that day. If your child is wearing a Christmas jumper, they will not be required to wear their blazer on this day, however, all other uniform expectations will apply, e.g. school trousers/skirt and school shoes. If your child is not wearing a Christmas jumper, FULL school uniform will be required.
