Dear Parents/Carers

We were delighted to welcome our pupils back last week. Thank you for your support in ensuring that they were ready for their return to school. I have been really impressed by how well pupils have settled back into school and how sensible they have been in getting used to new routines. As always, I feel very proud of our pupils. I am also immensely grateful to my staff who have worked very hard to ensure the safe and smooth return of pupils.

We will be conducting checks to ensure that all pupils have the required equipment.
- Following complaints, <u>please can you be considerate of our neighbours when dropping off and</u> <u>collecting pupils from school</u>. Please do not block private driveways and park on pavements etc.
- Please check the arrival time for your child below. Some pupils are arriving on site from 8.30am for a 9.00am arrival. Please ensure that your child arrives no more than 5 minutes in advance of their start time.
