Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you that **from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June, Year 13 students will only be required to attend college for their remaining examinations. The time spent at home should be used for exam preparation and revision.**

**It is important to note that subject teachers will still be available during their usual lesson time, should students wish to attend for additional support or revision.** Some subject teachers may also require some students to attend specific revision lessons. If this is the case, you will receive a text message outlining the requirements.

Similarly students who are studying BTEC qualifications and have outstanding work to complete are still expected to attend college as normal until their work has been completed and signed off by subject teachers.

Finally, in order to support with their next steps post Etone College, Mrs Barlow and Mrs Chase will be working with some students who will be required to attend at certain times for scheduled careers guidance and support with applications. You will be notified of these appointments via text.

Please may I take this opportunity to remind you that **A Level Results Day will take place on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> August 2022.** More information to follow on the school website and Twitter feed.

Students who have applied to University must accept a firm and insurance choice by 9<sup>th</sup> June on UCAS Track. Please note that they will only be able to do this when they have received a reply from all of their chosen universities. Failure to reply by the deadline will result in all offers being withdrawn.
