## Year 9 Black Country Museum - Tuesday 12th July

A trip has been arranged for Year 9 pupils to visit the Black Country Living Museum on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2022. The purpose of this trip is to assist with the learning of the Industrial Revolution in the UK, covered in both GCSE Geography and GCSE History. It will aim to make the events and people become more relevant to the pupils. The pupils will be undertaking a workshop whilst they are there to give them an insight into life during the Victorian era. The workshop is an example of a 1912 school lesson. Pupils will travel by coach departing at 9am and returning at approximately 3pm. Arrangements will need to be made for your child to return home safely.

School uniform will not be required but sensible clothing and shoes must be worn as part of the day. Pupils have the opportunity to pre-order fish and chips from the museum if they so wish at an additional cost, otherwise they will need to bring a packed lunch with them. Pupils entitled to free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch before departure, alternatively, they can also order fish and chips at an additional cost.

Etone College staff will be accompanying pupils on the trip. The total cost will be £19.50 per pupil. Pupil premium and free school meal children will receive a £1.95 reduction giving a total cost of £17.55.

**Payment should be made via your child's Wisepay account by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May**. Please complete and return the attached reply slip, along with your Wisepay receipt, to main school reception by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May. The consent slip needs to be completed and returned to school reception, as without this slip, your child will not be allowed to leave on the trip. Please also report any changes to your child's medical form held in school.

Please note that all places on trips are subject to continued good behaviour and regular attendance. Should your child be removed from the trip due to poor behaviour or attendance concerns, we would not accept liability for any payments made and no refunds will be issued. Additionally, the signed permission slip from yourself agrees that the school reserves the right to send your child home at your expense if your child jeopardizes their own safety, the safety of others or the good name of the school.
