At Etone College in addition to Music lessons on the curriculum, specialist musical instrument lessons are available via the Warwickshire Music service. There are also partially (50%) funded lessons available for pupils on Free School Meals or Pupil Premium, as well as free instrument hire. There are many different support packages for families available.

Once enough pupils at Etone have registered an interest in a particular instrument, a specialist teacher will be allocated to us and instrumental lessons will take place during the course of the day. Rotas are designed (where possible) to ensure that pupils do not miss the same portion of a classroom lesson each week. Pupils must be fully prepared for their lesson, remembering their instrument, books and other equipment.
