# Parking

As previously advised, for health and safety reasons and due to the location of our site on a main dual carriageway, we do not allow parking on site and the main entrance to school is closed at the start and the end of the day. Please do not try to drop off or collect pupils from our site. There are plenty of safe drop off points in the surrounding area only a short walk from our site. This is essential to protect the safety of our pupils as well as local road users.

Please also consider our neighbours and do not:-

- park on the private residential road opposite our site
- block private driveways
- stop on the dual carriageway or park on the pathway outside of school
- park in the neighbouring GP surgery as this is for patients only

Local traffic wardens regularly visit the area and you may receive a parking ticket or your vehicle may be clamped.

# <u>Uniform</u>

Full details of our uniform requirements can be found on our website and this includes photos of acceptable/unacceptable uniform. Regular uniform checks take place throughout the year and parents/carers will be contacted by House offices if pupils are not wearing the correct uniform.

# Equipment

Pupils should take responsibility for bringing their own equipment to school each day. We expect pupils to bring a suitable school bag (large enough to fit an A4 folder) containing: black pen, green pen, pencil, ruler, eraser, pencil sharpener, colouring pencils, calculator and an MFL dictionary.

In addition, pupils are required to bring the relevant exercise books to match their timetable for each day. If a pupil routinely fails to bring in the appropriate equipment this will lead to pupils receiving sanctions and communication home with yourselves. Pupils will receive weekly equipment checks with key checks across the year being and this will give the opportunity for pupils to receive Employability Skill points for Organisation.
