The Department for Education requires us to deliver the statutory guidance for Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE). This, alongside other key areas such as RE, Citizenship and Careers, makes up our Learning for Life curriculum which is delivered at Key Stage 5 through Learning for Life lessons, assemblies and curriculum days.
