Free Cycling Proficiency (Bikeability) Programme for Year 7 pupils

We are excited to be able to offer a free cycling proficiency course (Bikeability) to our Year 7 pupils. Bikeability is the government's national cycle training programme which helps children learn the practical skills and understand how to cycle safely on today's roads.

All pupils who wish to take part will be required to have their own bike and helmet. As the course will be taking place in school time, pupils will need to bring their bike and helmet to school on the relevant day. They will also need to bring a bike lock in order that their bike can be kept securely when not in use.

There are only a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come first served basis with priority being given to those pupils who travel to school by bike. Before places can be assigned, we need to know if pupils have undertaken the Bikeability programme before and at what level.
