Etone College Careers Fair – Wednesday 19th October 2022

We will soon be holding our annual Careers Fair at Etone College for pupils in all key stages. Pupils will be able to speak directly with employers, employees and educational administrators from a variety of different sectors as well as gain further insight into university life and gather information on apprenticeships or employment.

We have 30 confirmed exhibitors including, Royal Air Force, Royal Navy, Warwickshire Fire & Rescue, NHS Careers, Midland Training Group, NWSLC, Coventry College, AMTC, Coventry University, University of Birmingham, Loughborough University, to name but a few.
