Course Description:

This course is an opportunity to explore the world of business for any budding entrepreneur or economist. Designed to give pupils the opportunity to experience the key areas of business they will focus on Human Resources, Finance, Operations and Marketing. Theme 1: Investigating Small Businesses

Theme 2: Building a Business

Examines how a business develops beyond the start-up phase. It focuses on the key business concepts, issues and decisions used to grow a business, with emphasis on aspects of marketing, operations, finance, and human resources. Theme 2 also considers the impact of the wider world on the decisions a business makes as it grows.
