Dear Parent/Carer

The Department for Education requires us to deliver the statutory guidance for Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE). This, alongside other key areas such as RE, Citizenship and Careers, makes up our Learning for Life curriculum which is delivered at Key Stage 4/5 through assemblies, form time activities and curriculum days.

All Year 10, 11, 12 and Year 13 pupils will be participating in a curriculum day on **Monday 25th September**. This will replace their usual timetabled lessons.

Pupils will take part in the following sessions:

Year 10	Careers learning and Citizenship including: forms of Government, free press, personal information and Protected Characteristics.
Year 11	Careers learning and Citizenship including: The Judiciary, UK budget, worker's rights and finance and ASK apprenticeships.
Year 12	UCAS, careers and drug prevention and awareness.
Year 13	UCAS, careers and drug prevention and awareness.
