Homework Expectations

Our expectation is, that for every hour in the classroom, students spend one hour completing homework and / or independent study. This includes reading around the subject, getting ahead, continuing with any coursework elements and cementing knowledge from lessons.

It is also important that Year 12 & 13 students use their exam board website so that they can be fully prepared for their examinations (syllabus and past papers) and / or coursework.

Etone College expects every student in sixth form to complete homework as this is imperative to Post-16 study and beyond.

Any student who fails to produce homework or does not hand in work of an acceptable standard will be sanctioned by the classroom teacher. Continual failure to meet expectations will result in attending a meeting with the head of department or head of sixth form.
