You will receive a message/notification via Weduc/Matrix Academy Trust App (please turn on your notifications to ensure you receive messages) to inform you if your child is nominated to attend a session because they are below target. As a result, an after-school period 6 will show on their timetable. If your child is on or above their target grade, then these sessions are optional however we strongly advise your child attends. Last year pupils that regularly attended these additional sessions had an increased progress of at least 1 Grade. You can refer to the SIMS app for the most recent year 10 progress report.

In addition, we are looking to do further targeted intervention for Maths and English during Form Time.
