The Department for Education requires us to deliver the statutory guidance for Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE). This, alongside other key areas such as RE, Citizenship and Careers, makes up our Learning for Life curriculum which is delivered at Key Stage 4/5 through assemblies, form time activities and curriculum days.

All Year 10 pupils will be participating in a curriculum day on **Friday 20th October**. This will replace their usual timetabled lessons.

Pupils will take part in the following sessions:

- Choices and consequences of real-life situations including offensive language or gang related crime
- Making the right choices and consent
- The signs and effects of grooming
- Child on child abuse
- Choices when unplanned pregnancy occurs and how to be a good parent

Details of our RSHE Policy and an overview of the provision for each year group can be found on our website. **This content is statutory and forms a key part of our provision at school.**

This will be a normal school day and our usual high standards and expectations of behaviour will apply.
