Dear Parents/Carers

On return from half term, uniform and equipment checks will be taking place. During this week pupils have received assemblies to remind them of the standards expected. <u>Please ensure that</u> <u>your child returns on Monday 19th February in full school uniform worn in line with</u> <u>expectations to avoid unnecessary disruption.</u>

Please ensure you consult this guidance before making any purchase and pay particular attention to the not permitted items shown.

<u>Uniform</u>

All pupils must wear full college uniform on the way to and from school.

- Blazers should be worn at all times.
- Shirts should be tucked in and top shirt buttons must be fastened with the tie showing a minimum of six stripes.
- A plain black v neck jumper, containing no logo or branding, is optional in the winter.
- Plain black tights (not patterned).
- Formal black school shoes (which can be polished) should be worn no trainers, sports branded footwear, canvas pumps or boots. Shoes should be plain black only.
- Only standard <u>full-length</u> school trousers are permitted. No jeans, skinny/fashion style trousers, turn ups, ankle grazers or cropped trousers.
- Only Etone branded school skirts are permitted and these should be knee length.
- A plain coat (without graphics, slogans etc.) can be worn outdoors only <u>no hoodies or</u> <u>tracksuit tops are permitted</u>.
- No extreme hair fashions or brightly coloured/dyed hair. Short haircuts <u>MUST</u> be grade 2 or above. There should be no tramlines or shaved eyebrows.
- Only pupils in Key Stage 4 are permitted to wear <u>subtle</u> make-up. Key Stage 3 pupils should not wear any at all.
- False nails/gel nails are not permitted due to health and safety reasons and will be removed.
- False eyelashes are not permitted.
- Pupils are allowed to wear a wrist watch and one pair of gold or silver studs in the lower lobe. <u>These must be removed for PE lessons. No other piercings are permitted.</u>
- A **school bag** that will hold an A4 folder is essential. Please do not allow your child to have a large handbag for college.
