Etone Choir with Armonico Consort at the Royal Albert Hall

Etone College musicians have been invited to sing alongside **Armonico Consort at the Royal Albert Hall at 7pm on Tuesday 9th July 2024** as part of a massed choir of 2000 children and young people. This is an incredible opportunity to perform in the most famous concert venue in the UK and one of the most famous in the world.

Places are limited for this opportunity and will be issued on a first come, first served basis.

In order to prepare for this performance pupils need to regularly attend choir, maintain good attendance and as well as completing a workshops with the musicians from the Armonico Consort prior to the performance. Choir rehearsals take place each Friday in the Flex and the workshop date and time is to be confirmed,

On the day of the concert itself, pupils will travel by **coach** departing at **9:15am** for a rehearsal at **2:30pm** and returning at approximately **12am (midnight)**. Arrangements will need to be made for your child to return home safely from the school. If parents are attending the concert, pupils will be allowed to go home with you.

<u>The concert itself will be photographed and filmed professionally. By agreeing that your child is taking part in the concert you are also agreeing for them to appear in photographs of the event.</u>

As part of the concert dress, pupils will need to purchase a t-shirt for the concert as part of the concert dress. Please indicate on the additional form what size is required. If you took part in the Kings Singers concert last year, please bring in your t-shirt to the music department and you will be given a discount of £9 on this trip (£25 in full)

Pupils will be required to wear concert dress on the day: dark jeans/leggings and dark trainers/shoes as part of the concert dress. Pupils entitled to free school meals will be provided with a packed lunch before departure.

Etone College staff will be accompanying pupils on the trip. The total cost will be $\pounds 34$ per pupil to cover the cost of transport and for the cost of the t-shirts. The final date for all payments is I^{st} March 2024. Failure to pay in full by this date will result in your child being withdrawn from the trip. Pupil premium children will pay a reduced cost of $\pounds 30$.

Payment should be made via your child's Matrix Academy Trust App, **not in cash**. Please complete the consent form contained within the link below by **I**st **March 2024**. The consent needs to be completed, as without this, your child will not be allowed to leave on the trip. Please also report any changes to your child's medical form held in school.
