As part of the GCSE Geography course students are required to complete a fieldwork investigation which is based on an investigation carried out on a field trip, additionally 'Rivers' is one of the topics studied for the GCSE specification meaning it will also support their work in lessons. The visit will focus on the physical features and processes involved in the formation of rivers. Throughout the day students will carry out a range of surveys and data collection techniques which will be used in their exam.

As this trip forms the basis of the fieldwork investigation element of the course for the unit 3 exam it is essential all students studying Geography attend. The cost of the trip will be covered by the school as it is a requirement of the course.

The trip is scheduled to take place on **Wednesday 13th November. On this day 10A/G4, 10BG/1 and 10A/G2 (10A/G2-Pupils with surnames beginning with N-W) will be on the trip.**

Trip details;

- Wednesday 13th November 2024
- Transport to and from Carding Mill Valley is by coach
- Pupils must meet in the Café at **8.30am**
- Return to Etone at approx. **4pm**
- Pupils **must bring a packed lunch** as there is nowhere to purchase food, please indicate on the MS form below if you require a free school meal
- Pupils **must wear sensible walking shoes** as the terrain is uneven and the day will involve hill walking
- Uniform is not required as the whole day will be outdoors with no shade or shelter
- **Pupils who arrive without appropriate coat, outdoor clothing, or shoes will not be allowed on the trip and will be sent to lessons for the day**

Please note that all places on trips are subject to continued good behaviour and regular attendance. **Should your child be removed from the trip due to poor behaviour or attendance concerns, we would not accept liability for any payments made and no refunds will be issued.** Additionally, the consent from yourself agrees that the school reserves the right to send your child home at your expense if your child jeopardizes their own safety, the safety of others or the good name of the school.
