**Can I please remind you that parents/carers will not be allowed to drop off or collect pupils from site for health and safety reasons.** Parents and carers must arrange for the safe drop off and collection of their child away from school site. **Please consider our neighbours and do not block driveways or park in the GP surgery or on the dual carriageway.**

**Medical conditions**

**If your child has a medical healthcare plan, we will require a signed copy of this in school.** Additionally, should your child have a medical condition which requires them to have medication in school, please contact school reception on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September to arrange for you to bring in the required medication and to complete the relevant paperwork. We are unable to administer medication without written consent from parents/carers.

**Equipment**

Pupils are responsible for ensuring that they have all essential equipment each day. Please support us by providing a black pen, pencil, eraser, sharpener, maths set, calculator, crayons, glue stick, highlighters, MFL dictionary (please check with language your child studies). Year 7 will be advised of the language to be studied in September.



## **Uniform**

Please find detailed below, a reminder of our uniform requirements. Further details, as well as examples of correct and incorrect uniform, can be found on our website at [www.etonecollege/uniform/](http://www.etonecollege/uniform/).

### **Please ensure you consult this guidance before making any purchase and ensure your child is in full school uniform**

All pupils must wear full college uniform on the way to and from school.

- Blazers should be worn at all times.
- Shirts should be tucked in and top shirt buttons must be fastened with the tie showing a minimum of six stripes.
- A plain black v neck jumper, containing no logo or branding, is optional in the winter.
- Plain black tights (not patterned).
- Formal black school shoes (which can be polished) should be worn – no trainers, sports branded footwear, canvas pumps or boots. Shoes should be plain black only.
- Only standard full-length school trousers are permitted. No jeans, skinny/fashion style trousers, turn ups, ankle grazer, flares or cropped trousers.
- School skirts should be plain black and knee length, straight or pleated but NO lycra or stretchy material is permitted. An Etone branded school skirt is available.
- A plain black or blue coat (without graphics, slogans etc) can be worn outdoors only – hoodies and tracksuit tops are NOT permitted.
- No extreme hair fashions or brightly coloured/dyed hair. Short haircuts MUST be grade 2 or above. There should be no tramlines or shaved eyebrows.
- Only pupils in Key Stage 4 are permitted to wear subtle make-up. Key Stage 3 pupils should not wear any at all.
- False nails/gel nails are not permitted due to health and safety reasons and will be removed.
- False eyelashes are not permitted.
- Pupils are allowed to wear a wristwatch and one pair of gold or silver studs in the lower lobe. These must be removed for PE lessons. No other piercings or jewellery are permitted.
- A school bag that will hold an A4 folder is essential. Please do not allow your child to have a large handbag for college.


### **Uniform and equipment checks will take place regularly throughout the term.**
