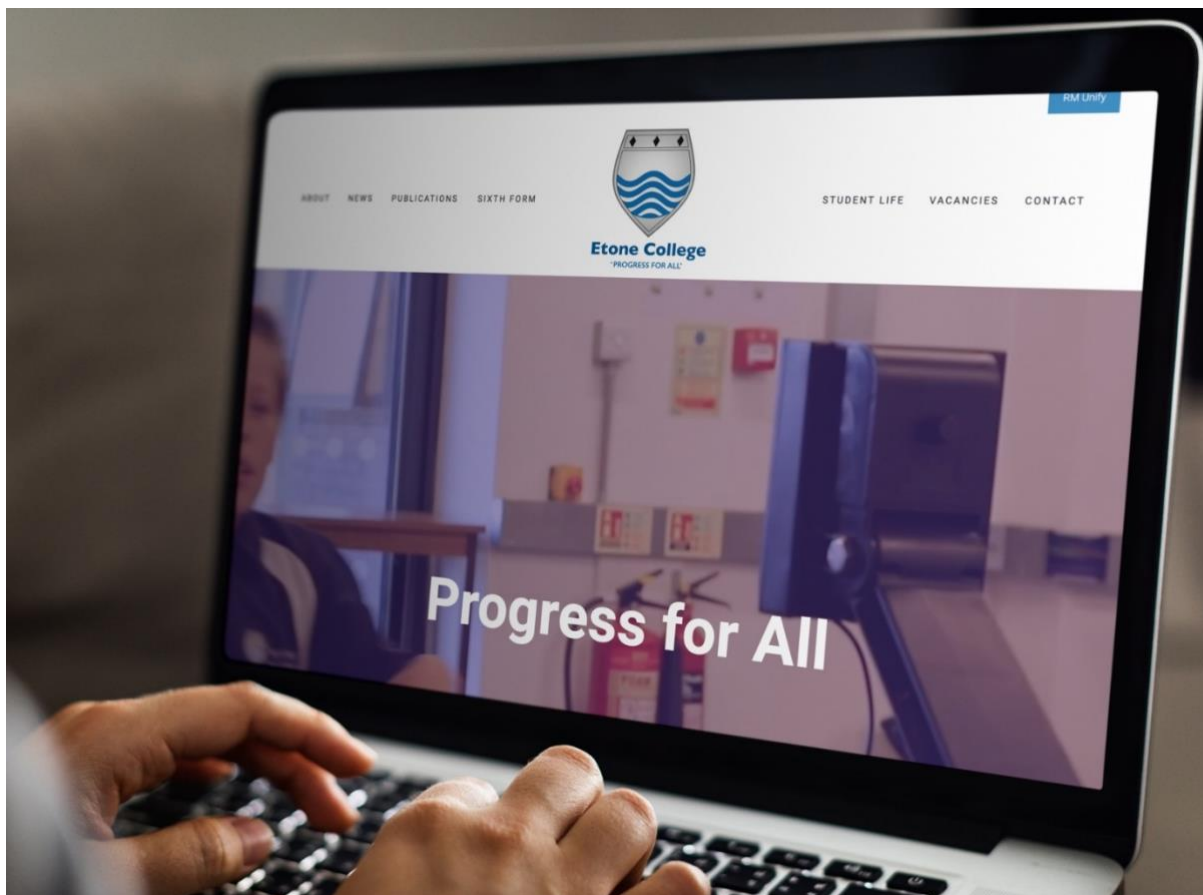


# **Parent Guide to the Etone Website**
