AQA Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) – Level 3 Qualification

- The EPQ allows you to **learn and develop skills** that you then apply to your own **independent** research project.
- There is a complete **free choice for the subject** of your EPQ.
- The **enrichment lessons** will be used to teach you these skills, the research project itself will be completed in your study time.

There are three parts to the assessment:

1. Either a 5,000 word essay or an artefact accompanied by a 1,000-5,000 word essay.
2. A logbook outlining and reflecting on how you managed your project.
3. A presentation to peers and staff, followed by questions.

The EPQ has four assessment objectives:

- **Manage** – identify, design, plan and carry out a project. Apply a range of skills, strategies and methods to achieve objectives.
- **Use resources** – research, critically select, organise and use information, and select and use a range of resources. Analyse data relevantly. Demonstrate understanding of the links, connections and complexities of your chosen topic.
- **Develop and Realise** – select and use a range of skills, take decisions critically and achieve planned outcomes.
- **Review** – evaluate all elements of your project.

Great for	Showing your interests to potential universities (some include the qualification in their offers). Showing readiness for university life. Developing your knowledge beyond the specification of one of your chosen level 3 subjects. Consideration if you miss your grades and applying through clearing.
