A member asked specific support for pupils with additional needs such as dyslexia and the use of IT	All classrooms are fitted with interactive whiteboards with user friendly dyslexia settings such as: - Adjustable Fonts and Sizes. - Customizable Colour Schemes. - Text Highlighting Tools. - Audio Playback Speed Control. - Visual Cues and Image Libraries. - Integration with Assistive Tech.
A member suggested that Year 11 pupils should have opportunities to discuss feelings related to exam pressure	Pupils have received Kooth online support for exam stress. Ongoing drop-in sessions (Brew Monday, 2 nd Monday of every month). Exam Stress Assemblies. Stress awareness leaflets and top tips shared via Weduc.
A member noted that moving from KS3 to KS4 pupils faced added pressures relating to GCSE courses	Parent and pupil support information to be provided at Y9 Options Evening. Information added to assemblies and pop up stands at break time to be introduced.



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
