Neurodiversity Month Activities – March 2026

As part of our ongoing commitment to an inclusive ethos at Etone and as part of our calendar of inclusion events, we are promoting Neurodiversity this March in a variety of ways.

Neurodiversity Month is an annual celebration founded by Sienna Castellon in 2018 to challenge stereotypes and misconceptions about neurological differences such as ADHD, autism, dyslexia and Tourette's. Here at Etone we want to celebrate the neurodiverse population of our school and ensure that all our school community can thrive.

Neurodiversity Month will begin with an informative assembly and a series of celebration posters around the school.

From Monday 2nd March to Friday 20th March – pupils will be able to take part in our 'Neurodiversity Awareness' competition by collecting a competition sheet from the library. All entrants will receive leadership house points as a reward and the winners will be rewarded with Easter eggs.

Every day in March there will be themed colouring activities in the main hall and cafe at lunch times to promote mindfulness and reflection.

For the whole of March, Key Stage 3 pupils will be able to take part in a form challenge to create a 60 second 'info film' to share their knowledge and understanding of neurodiversity. Each form will be able to choose how to present. This could be in the form of rap, a poster with voice over or an advert, the choice is theirs. The winning entries will be posted on the website to showcase Etone's celebration of Neurodiversity.
