### **Year 13 – Post Easter Updates and Changes**

As we return to school and approach the exam season, I wanted to share some important updates and reminders to support your child over the coming weeks. This will start from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> April.

#### **Updates and Reminders**

- With assemblies no longer taking place, weekly updates will be emailed to students so that they remain informed about key information.
- Students are no longer required to attend Monday morning registration (assembly), Period 1 LFL, or Monday Period 2 Enrichment lessons. If your child has a scheduled lesson during Period 2 on a Monday, they are expected to attend as normal.
- Interventions will be running in place of registration throughout the week. Please see the attached timetable.
- Year 13 students in the Football Academy should arrive at 9:15am for Monday Period 1 as they have a weekly revision with a focus on exam preparation and coursework.
- Students are encouraged to seek support at any time, either by speaking to staff in school or via email. “Time to Talk” sessions are available every Thursday and Friday lunchtime in the social area for wellbeing support with the Head of Sixth Form.
- Students have been provided with resources, attached alongside this letter, including a booklet on coping with exam stress and mental health strategies.
- Students can continue to access careers support and guidance to ensure they are ready for their next steps. Please see the attached careers support document. Students are also able to book a 1:1 meeting with our careers advisor if they require further guidance with post 18 careers.
- Students must bring their lanyards every day. If forgotten, they will be required to return home to collect them, which may result in missed revision sessions.
- The sixth form dress code policy remains in place throughout the exam season. This is smart casual, with no joggers and no facial piercings other than a small stud.
